- NoSQL database management systems challenging the status quo.
 - > Not plain replacement of traditional SQL based systems; commonly associated with particular quality properties that are desirable (e.g. ease-of-use).
- Technology is far from mature and sometimes lack in product quality.
 - > Drill deeper into those technologies that seem most likely to succeed.
 - > Optionally create real applications in order to test the system more thoroughly
